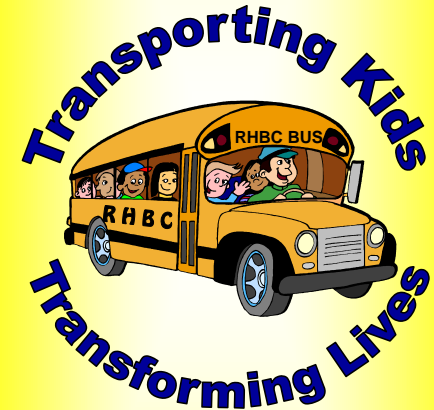

WHAT WE BELIEVE

The Bible tells us that the most important decision we can make is trusting Christ as our Savior. In so doing, we will begin a personal relationship with God and His Son Jesus Christ, and secure eternal life in heaven.

However, man has a **problem**: that problem is **sin**. Sin separates us from God.

For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. For there is not a just man upon the earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not. (Romans 3:23, Ecclesiastes 7:20)

Furthermore, there is a **penalty** for sin: that penalty is **death** and **Hell**. This death is an eternal separation from God and His love.

For the wages (payment) of sin is death. The soul that sinneth, it shall die. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. (Romans 6:23, Ezekiel 18:4, Revelation 20:14)

But God made a **solution** to this problem and its penalty: that solution was the sacrifice of His Son Jesus Christ upon the cross and his resurrection three days later.

But God commendeth (demonstrated) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Jesus said ... "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live." (Romans 5:8, John 11:25)

What must I do to be saved?

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved. If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. (Acts 16:31, Romans 10:9)

If you would like to receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior, you may ask Him to save you by talking to Him through a simple prayer like this:

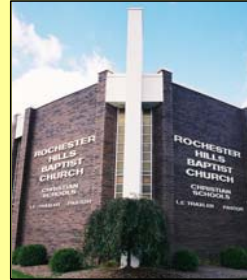
Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and that my sin keeps me from You and heaven. I believe You died on the cross and rose from the dead to take away my sins. Please forgive me, come into my life and save me. I receive You now. Amen.

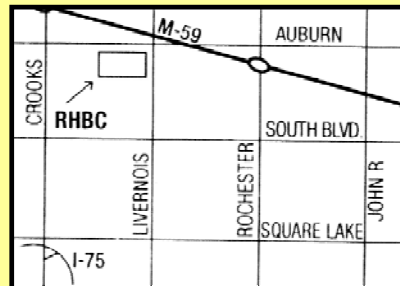

If you are interested in sending your child or coming yourself, we will send a bus to your house for pickup. Once church is over, we will take you back home.

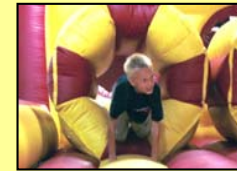
HOW TO SIGN UP
